- The exact origin of April Fool's Day is unknown, but it is believed to have started in France in the 16th century.
- The earliest recorded April Fool's Day prank was played on April 1st, 1698. It was a humorous story published in a London newspaper that stated that the moon was visible from the Earth.
- In Scotland, April Fool's Day is celebrated for two days, on April 1st and 2nd. The second day is known as Taily Day, where people play pranks on each other's tails.
- In France, April Fool's Day is known as Poisson d'Avril, which means April Fish. It's customary to place a paper fish on someone's back without them knowing.
- In India, Holi, the festival of colors, is celebrated on April 1st. It's a day of pranks, jokes, and laughter, and people play pranks on each other with colored water and powders.
- In Iran, April Fool's Day is celebrated on the 13th day of the Persian New Year, which is usually around April 1st.
- In medieval times, April Fool's Day was known as "Hilaria," a day of games and pranks. People would dress up in costumes and play tricks on each other.
- The famous comic strip "Peanuts" created by Charles Schulz featured a character named April Fool, who played pranks on his friends.
- The town of Gotham, in Nottinghamshire, England, claims to be the place where the tradition of April Fool's Day began. Legend has it that the townspeople played a prank on King John, and he was so impressed that he granted them exemption from tolls.

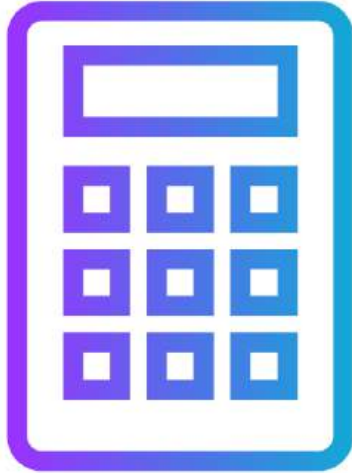

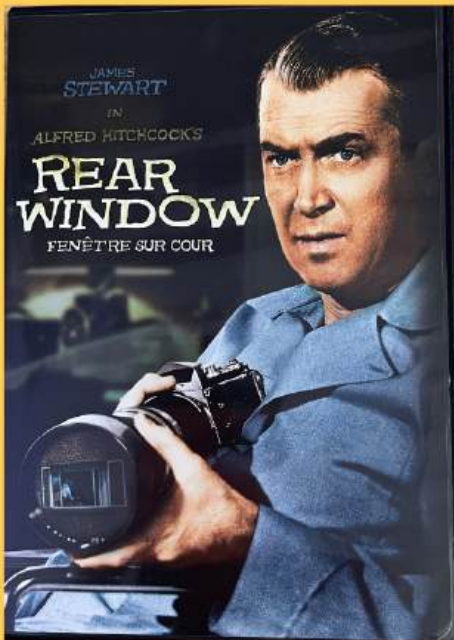

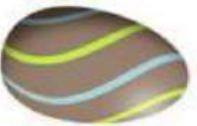
