





The Basics Of Safe Ice Walking: How To Walk On Ice



- Penguin Walk: Yes, you read that right. Mimic the waddle of a penguin by keeping your center of gravity over your front foot as you walk. It ensures that your full weight is distributed across the entire foot, reducing the risk of slipping.
- Slow and Steady: Rushing can be your enemy on icy surfaces. Take small, deliberate steps, ensuring that you place your whole foot down at once rather than leading with the toes.

Stay Flat-footed: While walking, try to stay as flat-footed as possible. It increases the surface area of your foot, ensuring maximum contact and grip.

Avoid Hands in Pockets: Keeping your hands out of your pockets ensures you can use them for balance. If you're carrying bags, distribute the weight evenly or use a backpack.

 Always Test the Surface: Before walking on what appears to be a clear path, test the surface. Black ice can often be invisible and is incredibly slippery. A simple tap with your foot can give you an idea of the surface condition.



OGDEN HOUSE HISTORY continued......

The following history address was given by Nancy Robinson

"Today is our great day, the day most of us thought would never happen. How often have you heard - We'll never see it happen. But it did and here we are making a start. We have many to thank for being able to raise the funds we needed. There are the Lions who have always given their support and raffled a motor home and turned the entire profits over to us. The Lions gave generously of their time and effort selling raffle tickets. The Legion who have always helped with donations and needed equipment from the very beginning of our club, the Canadian Pacific, The Imperial oil and many more small companies. Then of course we mustn't forget our members who gave and helped in any way they could to make that building fund grow. Then we must not forget our executives who have done a fantastic job for us. We don't realize the countless hours our President Cliff Harrison, secretary, Irene Roberts and our treasurer Olive Murray have put in. They have had to access countless pamphlets and filled mountains of forms on our behalf. We hear our secretary read out the minutes and our treasurer our money balances and think that is the end of it. They often spent a large part of many days through the week working on our behalf, and they deserve our gratitude. We also have to thank our members of Parliament who have been behind us all the way and who persuaded the Government to release enough of the funds from the lotteries to bring our bank balance high enough to make our dream come true.
