

ROBBIE BURNS DAY JANUARY25



Robert Burns (25 January 1759 – 21 July 1796), was a Scottish poet and lyricist. He is widely regarded as the <u>national poet</u> of <u>Scotland</u> and is celebrated worldwide. He is regarded as a pioneer of the <u>Romantic movement</u>, and after his death he became a great source of inspiration to the founders of both <u>liberalism</u> and <u>socialism</u>, and a cultural icon in Scotland and among the <u>Scottish diaspora</u> around the world. Celebration of his life and work became almost a national <u>charismatic cult</u> during the 19th and 20th centuries, and his influence has long been strong on <u>Scottish literature</u>
